ESM Cricket Academy (ESMCA) Code of Conduct

(Adopted from the Buckinghamshire Code of Conduct)

Please note that failure to abide by this code of conduct will mean that the player will be prohibited from participating in the ESM Cricket Academy (ESMCA) Coaching sessions.

1. The Player Agrees to

- (a) Work towards the attainment of his/her full potential
- (b) Attend ESMCA events regularly and punctually, behave with self-discipline.
- (c) Listen to and take on board guidance given by ESMCA coaching staff
- (d) Practice the techniques and skills taught by the ESMCA coaching staff
- (e) Abide by the Laws of cricket and the ethos contained in the MCC 'Spirit of Cricket'
- (f) Behave and dress in an appropriate manner
- (g) Not to use alcohol or tobacco, or any other stimulant or harmful substance.
- (h) Neither possesses nor uses any prohibited drugs
- (i) Not to take any unnecessary risks
- (j) Not to use foul language whilst under the guidance of ESMCA
- (k) Not to attempt to intimidate or use aggressive behaviour
- (I) Treat all players as you would like to be treated
- (m) Co-operate with coaches, team-mates, officials and volunteers
- (n) Remember playing cricket is fun

2. The Parents / Guardians Agree to:

- (a) Encourage and help the players meet targets, including abiding by the Code of Conduct
- (b) Support the players without pressure, praise good work and refrain from criticising lapses
- (c) Know and understand why your son/daughter is playing. The objective of ESMCA is to provide a high quality learning environment, to improve techniques, but above all to encourage enjoyment of the sport
- (d) Set a good example to the player
- (e) Respect the opportunity given to the player
- (f) Communicate with the ESMCA staff , keeping them informed about matters affecting the
- (g) Refrain from coaching or interfering with the coaching of the player during any ESMCA sessions as you have entrusted the player to us for hi/her cricketing development
- (h) When encouraging and supporting the player, do so in a calm and controlled manner.
- (i) If you have any concerns you are entitled to approach the ESMCA coach(es) and discuss any issues with him/her.
